

# **RAB RIGLOS SUITE, A HIGH-LEVEL EXPERIENCE**

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## 1 Introduction

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We invite you to live the Rab Riglos Suite adventure, the original and unforgettable experience of spending the night on a portaledge, suspended 100 meters above the ground on the sheer cliffs of the Mallos de Riglos, in the Pre-Pyrenees, Huesca.

Each room can accommodate one or two portaledges. These can each sleep two people, allowing for a maximum of four per room. So whether you are looking for a romantic night with a partner, or an adventure with friends, you are catered for.

A unique experience in a privileged natural environment, accessible to everyone, with or without climbing experience, who want to make this dream come true, and enjoy the great alpinists' sensations.

## 2 The destination

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**Riglos**, in the region of Hoya de Huesca, located in the Pre-Pyrenees of Aragon, is a best known village to climbers, mountaineers and tourists from all over the world, due to its majestic **Mallos**. It is located in a rich natural environment, on the Banks of the **Gallego River**, which allows the practise of many water activities of active tourism.

It is a particularly attractive destination for lovers of **ornithology**, as Riglos has Europe's largest colony of **griffon vultures**, as well as a great diversity of raptors and other birds.

Its privileged location, **pleasant microclimate** and an ideal environment for active tourism activities, make Riglos the best location for the development of this activity.

In addition to the possibilities of active tourism, Riglos, as a town belonging to the region of La Hoya de Huesca, also offers **great cultural attractions**; **The castle of Loarre**, one of the best preserved monument from the medieval, or the **Collegiate of Bolea** are a small sample of it.

Another great tourist attraction is the **gastronomy** of the area, with a high quality and awarded cuisine. There are wineries in the area whose wines, with designation of origin, compete to a high national and international level.

Riglos is located **40 km from Huesca**, and **114 km from Zaragoza**. Zaragoza has international airport and high speed train (AVE). Huesca is also connected by high-speed train (AVE). Access to Riglos is done by road by private vehicle or by train.

## 3 Basic information

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Destination: **Los Mallos de Riglos**. Huesca. Spain.

Activity: Climbing with overnight stay on the wall

Difficulty: Prior climbing experience is not required.

Duration: 15 hours

Season: All year. Best seasons are spring and autumn.

Minimum-maximum group: 1-4 people

### 3.1 Difficulty remarks and observations

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- For this room/site no prior climbing experiences is required. It is an opportunity to have a "climbing baptism" and you can reach the portaledge through varied and easy routes.
- If you don't want to climb up, there is the possibility of reaching the portaledge by foot, through the back side of the Mallo (about 1h30min). It is not a very technical access, but you will be assured by the guide, as it is a rugged area.

## 4 Programme

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### Day 1. Meeting point in Riglos and ascent to the portaledge

If the client goes on his own, the meeting point will be in Riglos, in front of the Riglos Hut around 17h in spring and summer and around 14h in autumn and winter.

The guide will explain the last details of the ascent to the portaledge (previously installed) and he will give you the required equipment. Time for questions.



We will start climbing towards Colorado room about 3 hours before the sunset though the selected route (from IV to 6ª degree) or by foot through the back side Access (1h 30 min approximately).

Once in the portaledge the guide will make a reminder of the security measures and he will explain how to get to the portable toilet. The dinner will be delivered and served in the natural balcony, just in front of the portaledge, where you will enjoy the dinner and the magical sunset views. You will have a walkie-talkie to contact the guide for anything you could need, as he will be in the surrounding area during the whole night.



## Day 2. Climbing up to the Summit and descent until the ground.

At 8.00h breakfast will be delivered and we will climb up to the summit, at just some meters over the portaledge location. From the summit we will star the descent by rappel to the ground.



## 5 More information

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Price. 450€ (1 person), 550€ (2 people), 900€ (4 people)

### 5.1 Included in the price

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- Guided ascent to the portaledge with a profesional climbing guide.
- Accommodation in the portaledge (Capacity for 2 people).
- Dinner in a natural balcony in from of the protaledge if weather conditions allow it, or inside the portaledge. The menu is elaborated by the prestigious restaurant *La Venta del Sotón*.
- Breakfast served in the portaledge.
- Guided descent to the ground.
- Security equipment (Ropes, helmets, harnesses, headlights, carabiners...) and sleeping mats for the portaledge.
- Portable toilet and bag for waste. Bottle of water.
- Accident insurance for the participants.

### 5.2 Not included in the price

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- Flights and transport to Riglos. Muntania Outdoors could manage the transport (please consult).
- Sleeping bags (Available for rent. Please consult)
- Climbing shoes (Available)
- VIP dinner (Please consult special menus)
- Professional photographer during the ascent or drone filming (Please consult)

### 5.3 Required equipment

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It is recommended to wear comfortable clothes for climbing and suitable to spend the night depending on the season.

- Climbing shoes
- Sleeping bad according to season
- Thermal t-shirt and pants in winter
- Essential toiletries

### 5.4 Observations

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- It is not necessary to have any knowledge of climbing, since the activity is developed at all times with a professional guide.
- It is possible to adapt the menus according to possible allergies, intolerances or preferences (vegetarian, vegan, etc.)
